## VA Nurse Emeritus

### What is VA Nurse Emeritus?

- **VA Nurse Emeritus** membership is comprised of NOVA members who have retired from the Department of Veterans Affairs or who plan retirement within the next calendar year.

### How much does it cost to join?

- **VA Nurse Emeritus** members who have retired pay the Emeritus (Retired) membership fee for NOVA membership which is \$50.00 per year. There is no additional cost to belong to VA Nurse Emeritus.

### Where and How do members meet?

- **VA Nurse Emeritus** members meet monthly (4th Monday) via conference call (Toll free number). The meetings last approximately 1 hour.
